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YEAR 2 – DAILY ROUTINES

- Homework and reading books will be given on a Friday. They are due back on a **Wednesday**.
- Please ensure you have signed the reading record.
- Spellings will be given on a Friday. They will be stuck in the back of the home school diary. The test will take place every **Thursday**.



YEAR 2 – DAILY ROUTINES

- Pupils are expected to line up in the playground after the bell at 8.25am, we would request parents to leave their child in the line to allow students in as quick as possible.
- Home – School Diaries to be bought in every day.



YEAR 2 – DAILY ROUTINES

- At the end of the day pupils will be released one by one by the teacher.
- When collecting your child from the classroom door, please do not crowd the door. We would request you stand to one side to ensure all pupils are dismissed safely. Should you wish to talk to the class teacher please wait until pupils have been dismissed.
- If someone else is collecting your child you **must** inform the school office prior to collection.



YEAR 2 – DAILY ROUTINES

- We expect all pupils in full school uniform every day; should for any reason your child be missing a part of their uniform please let the class teacher know and replace it as soon as possible.
- All staff at GNSA are vigilant on uniform standards; we would appreciate in this being reinforced by yourselves as they come into school every morning.
- Please note black trainers are not part of the uniform.



HOME SCHOOL LEARNING

- Different types of homework- written, speaking and listening, outdoor experiences.
- Please make use of the online learning resources purchased by the school; your child will have their login for:
 - Bug Club
 - Mangahigh
- If your child is unable to access these learning resources, please let the class teacher know so we can arrange for them to use them in school.



READING IN YEAR 2

- Please ensure your child reads for at least 10 minutes every day.
- This can include their reading book, library book, a text they have been allocated on Bug Club or a book they have at home.



WRITING IN YEAR 2

- The basics- capital letters and full stops.
- Understanding different word types, i.e. adjectives, nouns and verbs.
- Understanding different types of punctuation.
“Did you have a nice time at the party?”
“Stop that right now!”
- **Ensuring writing is coherent and makes sense.**



MATHS IN YEAR 2

- Confident understanding of the four operations: + - x ÷
- Able to count in 2s, 5s and 10s forwards and backwards.
- Know the value of different coins.
- Know the basic properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
- Confident understanding of number families to 10 and 20.

E.g. $6 + 4 = 10$ $4 + 6 = 10$ $10 - 4 = 6$ $10 - 6 = 4$

If you receive any of the following, the school may be entitled to receive funds on your child's behalf.

Please complete the online eligibility check if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- *Income Support*
- *Income-based Jobseekers Allowance*
- *Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999*
- *The guaranteed element of the State Pension Credit*
- *Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16, 190)*
- *Working Tax Credit run on- paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit Universal Credit.*
