Sport Funding Report

School Overview

At Nanaksar Primary School, we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of our pupils. We believe that an innovative, varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all our pupils.

What is Primary School Sport Funding? (PSSF)

The Government is providing funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16 and 2016/17 to provide new, substantial primary school sport funding. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport and will see money going directly to primary school Headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children.

Our Primary School Sport's Funding will enable us to continue and extend our provision through employing additional sports professionals, building upon on resources and equipment and training our staff to deliver in-house quality PE sessions.

Purpose of the funding

Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Possible uses of the funding could include hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE, running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games.

| Life Bus | £590.50 | Providing pupils with the opportunity to visit the bus for an interactive session on healthy living and our human body. Promote making healthy choices and leading an active lifestyle. |
| PSD Targeted Clubs | £560.00 | Targeted PE clubs for Year 2 & Year 3 pupils |
| Pantry: Health and Well-being Week | £170.00 | Healthy snacks provided for the week to promote a healthy lifestyle. |
