Sport Funding Report

School Overview

At Nanaksar Primary School, we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of our pupils. We believe that an innovative, varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all our pupils.

What is Primary School Sport Funding? (PSSF)

The Government is providing funding of £150 million per annum to provide substantial primary school sport funding. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport and will see money going directly to primary school Headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children.

Primary School Sports Funding for 2019-20 is enabling us to continue and extend our provision by employing additional sports coaches, entering into more competitive sports competitions, providing swimming lessons and training our staff to deliver high quality PE and Games sessions.

Purpose of the funding

Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Possible uses of the funding could include hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE, running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games.

Funding Allocation & Expenditure for 2019-2020 – Expenditure to Date and Proposed Expenditure

Item	Expenditure	Information & Impact
PE Equipment	£377.94	PE resources to support REAL PE Lessons and active playtimes. This has enabled existing equipment to be topped up and has resulted in brand new resources being ordered, to provide pupils with opportunities to access a broader range of activities.
NPS Team Sports Kits	£503.55	Unisex pupil sport's kits for team competitions. This has motivated and incentivised pupils to represent the school, promoting teamwork and healthy competition.
Sports Leaders Award	£306.50	A launch of a new primary leadership package. The PlayMaker Award is an introduction into leadership for pupils or students aged nine and over. The package has enabled a team of pupils to take part in weekly workshops promoting leadership skills within sports, including the provision of learning journals and certificates.
PSD Lunch Time Active Play Targeted After School Clubs	£4526.00	Coach led active playtime sessions during lunch times, to increase physical activity through multi-sports. Targeted clubs offered to pupils to promote an active healthy lifestyle with Primary Sporting Development.
PSD Football Coaching	£2565.00	Professional coaching for selected pupils, who train together and take part within internal and external football tournaments.
PSD CPD Session	£350.00	CPD Provided by Primary Sporting Development, to support teachers in delivering high quality PE lessons through the REAL PE scheme.
Sports Director: Basketball Coaching	£604.00	Professional basketball coaching for pupils, who also enter borough wide competitions to network with other schools and develop team working skills.
Full Court Connection: Resources to support team games	£2730.00	New resources to support after school clubs and daily PE lessons, related specifically to the 'games' topic.
